DOES YOUR FORMER EMPLOYER OWE YOU MONIES?

SERVICE CANADA MAY BE ABLE TO HELP YOU!

You may be eligible to receive up to \$8,278.83 (2023 maximum amount) through the Wage Earner Protection Program (WEPP) if:

- ✓ Your employment has ended
- ✓ Your former employer is bankrupt, is subject to a Receivership or other qualifying insolvency proceedings
- √ You are owed monies from your former employer, notably in form of wages, vacation pay, termination pay, or severance pay
- ✓ Owed monies were earned during eligible periods

File for WEPP in 2 easy steps!



The Trustee/Receiver will send you a proof of claim form. You will need to review, complete and sign it. Then, send it back to the Trustee/Receiver who will submit the information to Service Canada.

Trustees & Receivers are there to help you

They are appointed under the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* to administer the estate of your former employer. They help determine the amount claimed under the WEPP.



What happens after your <u>online</u> application?

Service Canada will:

- Review your application and the information from the Trustee/Receiver
- Confirm if you are eligible for WEPP
- Inform you of their decision in writing, usually within in a 35-day period
- Issue payment directly to you (if you are eligible)
